



Originally an industrial city in the second half of the 20th century, it is now perhaps the brightest representative of positive transformation in the whole of Slovakia. Košice has become an ideal place for creative work in the environment of a local metropolis, away from the hectic world of European cities.

Good accessibility of Košice from the world is now a matter of course and at the same time a great added value for those who are considering a larger or smaller professional meeting or event. More than 300 cities can be reached by air directly or with a single transfer. The natural convenience and "human" dimension of the local airport, as well as the fact that it is part of the Schengen area, makes it an ideal choice. It sounds unbelievable, but for a passenger with hand luggage, the historic centre of Košice is literally 15 to 20 minutes away from getting off the plane. The very offer of existing spaces for various types of professional, social and exhibition events make Košice a gracious and sympathetic MICE destination. Its uniqueness

is also in its location in the middle of a wider, yet compact, tourist destination, which is as close as it gets for a visitor to Košice! Within just a 100-minute drive, there are up to 18 UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Numerous picturesque places are worth a visit, where nature combines with tradition and culture, such as in the Tokaj, the smallest Slovak wine-growing region. Escape from civilisation and everyday stress is offered by the green ravines and vast plains of the Slovak Paradise and the Slovak Karst National Parks, and time travel is a privilege of the exceptionally preserved medieval landscape, which is still dominated by the majestic Spiš Castle – the symbol of Slovakia.

Košice thus, in addition to a quality infrastructure suitable for professional work, also offers countless opportunities for a quick, but intense, trip out of the city. The Vivid City of Košice

The uniqueness of Košice today lies in its cultural diversity and the open atmosphere created by the inhabitants and the architecture of the city. Košice is a local metropolis that lives. The historic centre is the best proof of this. From early morning to late evening it is on the move, best represented by the vibrant promenade. The people here live not only in the city, but also "by the city", and thus become an integral part of the Košice "genius loci". The authentic human element is perhaps one of the strongest emotions that visitors take

away from Košice. These are also the reasons why Košice is popular among organisers of social, cultural, and sporting events. The second oldest marathon in the world, an international film festival, the World Hockey Championship, or an international air show regularly bring tens of thousands of visitors – participants and spectators – to Košice. In recent years, Košice has also become the venue of several events of European and world importance, which have further augmented the image of a vibrant city.

5 sites not to be missed in Košice

- The St. Elizabeth Cathedral, considered to be the easternmost Gothic cathedral in Europe, is undoubtedly the most historically and culturally significant monument of Košice.
- While strolling through the historic centre, be sure to make a stop at the oldest gastronomic institution in Slovakia, founded in 1542. Today it is home to the Pivovar Hostinec (Brewery Inn) restaurant.
- Main Street is the longest, most beautiful and lively promenade in Slovakia. Once a common bourgeois custom, now an old-world tradition – the phenomenon of promenading has been exceptionally preserved in Košice until today.
- The Singing Fountain is a magnet for locals and visitors of all age groups. Situated in the heart of the Main Street, between the Cathedral and the National Theatre, it is a popular place for rendezvous.
- Tabačka Kulturfabrik is a cult place of the independent creative scene in Košice, known all over Slovakia. This original building of an old tobacco factory, in direct contact with the old town, guarantees an intense experience on every occasion.









We are UNESCO 18 sites within 100 minutes' drive from Košice

The Košice region locale, and the whole of Eastern Slovakia in its wider range, is peppered with interesting monuments and sites that are hallmarked as the world heritage. Visitors may comfortably get to as many as 18 sites inscribed on the UNESCO List of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage within 100 minutes by car. Such a dense cluster of UNESCO natural and cultural sites is found nowhere else in Europe. It is exceptional in its composition. It includes a unique collection of six world-famous caves, the original preserved Carpathian beech forests, wooden sacral buildings, medieval towns within their original walls, and one of the largest castle complexes in the world, which is today a symbol of Slovakia. This high concentration of the world heritage sites stands for another fantastic added value for congress organisers. Quick accessibility of those sites, their historical, aesthetic, and cultural significance, makes the Košice Region Slovakia an inspirational place for any visitor.



Dobšinská lce Cave


Dobšinská Ice Cave is one of the largest ice caves in the world and in terms of ice volume it is the absolute world leader. Until 1946, public ice skating was even allowed in it!











Ochtinská Aragonite Cave

It is one of the four accessible aragonite caves in the world. Its monumental karst decoration is formed by three generations of aragonite, the oldest of which is almost 140 thousand years old.

Domica Cave

A cruise down the underground river Styx? The longest cave in the Slovak UNESCO collection offers such a unique opportunity. Domica is also the only cave open all year round, from February to December.

Vihorlat Forest

The oldest beech trees of Vihorlat forest are up to 240 years old. Both difficult accessibility of these natural areas and their systematic preservation have contributed to the fact that the habitat of the beech primeval forests exists in its original harmony.

Ruská Bystrá

This subtle yet impressive sacral building dates to 1730. The Temple of the Transfer of the Relics of St. Nicholas is situated in the beautiful surroundings of the Sub-Vihorlat Forests, in the tiny village of Ruská Bystrá.





Kežmarok

The wooden articular church - the Church of the Holy Trinity — was built by the Protestants of Kežmarok in a record duration of 3 months in 1717. The interior of the church, including the entire ceiling, is decorated with spectacular murals exclusively on wood.

Levoča


The beautiful historical centre of Levoča is surrounded by exceptionally well-preserved medieval walls with a length of more than 2 kilometres. The Church of St. James in Levoča is home to the world's tallest late Gothic wooden altar. 18.6 metres tall.

Bardejov

In addition to the city walls, the Gothic gate and 10 bastions have been preserved in Bardejov. The Basilica of St. Aegidius, with its 11 Gothic wing altars, is one of the most precious of Bardejov's medieval buildings and is unique in Europe.

Spiš Castle

One of the largest castle complexes in the world is not only the most photogenic site of the Košice Region, but also the pride of the whole Slovakia. The Spiš Castle covers 4 hectares and the oldest mention of it dates to 1249.







Tokaj is the place where gastronomy meets nature. This viticultural region is well known not only for its wine, but also for its rich history and traditions closely connected to the local environment. It is the smallest wine region in Slovakia, but also unique. It goes under the slogan of "TOKAJ IS THE ONLY ONE". And sure, there is no other place like this in the world! While the smaller part of historical Tokaj region is situated in southeastern corner of Slovakia, the bigger part belongs to Hungary. History of the local winemaking goes back to 13th century. The unique taste of Tokaj

wine is created by region's subsoil of volcanic origin and the special climate. Only three varieties of grape are approved for Tokaj labelling - Lipovina, Muskat Yellow, and Furmint. Many aristocrats adored this wine over the centuries and the French emperor Louis XIV himself once declared Tokaj to be "the King of Wines – the Wine of the Kings". Today, the Tokaj wine region is once again experiencing its golden age. More than 200 awards from national and international exhibitions in recent years are sufficient proof of it.











9 places that define Slovak Tokaj

Tokaj vineyards

Exactly 907 hectares of precisely defined vineyards, in seven Slovak municipalities, form the territory on which grape varieties intended to produce naturally sweet Tokaj wines can be grown.

Observation tower

The iconic lookout tower has been a modern symbol of Tokaj since 2015. The visually and visitor-appealing structure in the shape of a wine barrel, which also won one of the national architecture awards, towers over the vineyards.

Historical farmhouse cellars

The area of the historical farmhouse cellars in the village of Veľká Tŕňa is a place where the history of the original medieval tufa cellars is combined with the modern life and work of the local community of small family wineries.

Ostrožovič Winery

It is a well-established brand not just in Slovakia, but also in the world. The Ostrožovič winery has been a guarantee of quality for more than 30 years, not only in the production of Tokaj wines, but also in the offer of tourism experiences.

Historical cellar TOKAJ&CO s.r.o

The largest complex of historic cellars in Tokaj dates to the 14^{th} century and is a national cultural monument. It has a total length of 2.5 km and houses 1500 barrels, two tasting rooms, and a wine archive.

Tokaj Macik Winery

So far, the only BIO certified winery in the Tokaj winegrowing region. It is the only one to offer visitors, in addition to wines, also Tokaj beer and is an ideal choice for enthusiasts of agrotourism.

The Golden Tassel Cellar (Zlatá Putňa)


Another historic medieval cellar with a unique tasting room is part of a typical Tokaj family winery, where three generations of winemakers are already working.


Grange Bara (Majer Bara)

Winery as a place for active relaxation – this is the concept of Grange Bara, where in addition to wine and regional gastronomy, they also offer relaxation in nature, on horseback or in the saddle of a bicycle.

Chateau Grand Bari

The Chateau Grand Bari winery is a modern spin on the Tokaj tradition, surprising one by its interesting architecture and by the unusual finish of its wines.





The unique areas of the national parks **Slovak Paradise** and **Slovak Karst** are a separate 'green planet' of the Košice Region Slovakia. They offer unique natural scenery and fascinating biodiversity, which is exceptional even on a European scale.

The deep gorges of the **Slovak Paradise**, surrounded by steep rock walls and roaring waterfalls, create a stunning panorama, while the number and concentration of these gorges in a relatively small area makes this national park unique in Europe. The technical facilities that make it possible to navigate the difficult terrain have become an integral part of the park and its symbol. In perfect harmony with nature, bridges, ladders, platforms and chains, they provide access to this breathtaking wild nature reserve.










The Slovak Karst is a unique place where nature hides underground. More than 1,000 caves and sinkholes with various forms of sinter and ice fill have been discovered on the vast karst plains and beneath their surface. Such a density of caves is unlikely to be found anywhere in the world in temperate climates.



Slow Travel

Walk, sit, talk, drink, eat, and enjoy yourself! The Košice Region Slovakia is a destination where slow travel is one of its defining elements. From the international airport, which surprises with its peaceful atmosphere, to the wooden temple in Ruská Bystrá, charmingly surrounded by the greenery of mighty linden trees, the visitors may slow down the pace of their own hectic life and authentically immerse themselves in the local culture, nature, and the traditional lifestyle of the local people. All this is possible in the numerous locations that are not overcrowded with tourists and therefore naturally provide ample time and opportunity to immerse oneself in the daily life of the local communities and to understand them better. Places where the aim is not to see as many attractions as possible in a short time, but to enjoy a peaceful stay, the destination is literally dotted with them. Tokaj vineyards and the stretching dykes of the nearby Bodrog River. The vast plateaus of the Slovak Karst and the abandoned industrial monuments in its valleys. Castle ruins on the hills with stunning views and well-preserved manor houses in the villages below. Vast ponds with flocks of birds and peaceful forests with mighty oaks. And finally, the historic streets of the city of Košice with its countless quiet corners hiding fragrant cafés.
















Air transport

MMF Art Film

MMF Art Film is a major international film festival held annually in Košice and is one of the oldest film festivals in Slovakia. Its line-up consists of a selection of the best contemporary films representing a wide range of genres and filmmakers. Films from all over the world compete here, with the Blue Angel award going to films in the Best Film category. Other awards are for Best Director and Best Actor. Non-competitive cult films and films by award-winning international filmmakers complete the line-up. The festival aims

at promoting artistic film and gives a platform to young talents and emerging directors. In addition to film screenings, it offers a comprehensive accompanying programme including discussions, lectures and meetings with filmmakers. This gives visitors the opportunity to get to know more about the filmmaking process and current trends in cinema. Art Film Fest is therefore not just about the films, but also about the overall atmosphere created in Košice by viewers, filmmakers, and guests from all over the world. Every year, the event

attracts not just film enthusiasts, but also many professionals from the film industry who come to present their works or share their experiences at discussions and workshops, making Košice a centre of cultural events and audience interest. The festival also includes special awards, which are given to personalities of Slovak and world cinema for their lifelong contributions to cinema. The festival thus becomes a unique platform for celebrating the art of film and a platform for discovering new talents.






White Night / Nuit Blanche

White Night in Košice is one of the largest contemporary art festivals in Slovakia, attracting thousands of visitors every year. Every year since 2010, this festival has transformed the city into a night gallery full of light, sound, and interactive installations. The artworks, created by leading Slovak and international artists, make use of modern technology and unconventional settings such as buildings, parks, and city streets for their presentation. The aim of the festival is to make contemporary art accessible to the general public and encourage them to explore new forms of creativity. The festival encompasses a variety of genres – from video mapping, to sculptures, light installations, and "performance".

Visitors will find more than just visual experiences to enjoy during the festival. The festival agenda often includes interactive works that engage the audience and create a connection between the viewer and the artist. During the White Night, the streets of Košice are transformed from dusk into a surreal place where everyday places become the focus of fascinating light games and audiovisual experiences.





The festival adds an international dimension to Košice, annually presenting the works of renowned international artists who share their unique approaches to art and the use of modern technologies. Thanks to this diversity, the White Night has become a significant cultural phenomenon that brings contemporary art closer to all generations and attracts visitors from all over Slovakia and abroad to Košice.









Aviation Days of the Košice Region

The Košice Region Aviation Days is a prestigious show of international standing, which brings one of the largest air shows in Slovakia to Košice. Every year, a two-day programme full of aerial acrobatics, historical and modern aircraft, and premiere performances is presented on the ground and in the sky of the Košice Airport. Visitors from all over Slovakia and abroad may experience fascinating aerial performances by pilots from different countries, including simulated aerial duels and pyrotechnic effects.

There is also a packed accompanying programme, interactive attractions, and family activities. The show is known for repeatedly attracting crowds of spectators to Košice curious about the art of top European pilots, their aerobatic performances, demonstrations of the Slovak Air Force, and presentations of modern and historical aircraft. Visitors thus have a unique opportunity to admire the development of aviation technology in direct demonstrations and in intensive contact with the overall happenings at the airport.

The air show also offers a rich accompanying programme for families with children, including animation activities, competitions, a photo booth and mascots, which makes the show an exceptional experience for all age groups.

Each year, the programme of the Aviation Days of the Košice Region combines aviation history with modern technology, creating a unique atmosphere that excites all aviation and technology enthusiasts, regardless of their age. Each year brings innovative elements and attractive novelties that ensure its sustainable success and attractiveness in the field of aviation events in Slovakia.









Margecany Festival of Delicacies

Margecianske Fajnoty (Festival of Delicacies) is a unique international gourmet two-day festival, which has been held annually since 2011 in the village of Margecany. This event attracts connoisseurs of not only traditional Slovak cuisine from the historical regions of Spiš, Šariš, Gemer, and Abov, but also international cuisine specialties. The aim is to preserve well-known and almost forgotten recipes of our ancestors and to present the procedures of their preparation. More than 100 different dishes are prepared in front of the audience according to traditional recipes. In addition to satisfying the taste buds, the festival

also offers a varied cultural framework of the venue, made up of performances by folklore groups, wellknown musical groups, children's performances, and craft demonstrations.

The festival is therefore attractive not just as a celebration of food; it is also a venue where people come together to experience the atmosphere of the local markets, showcase their cooking and craft skills, and enjoy a varied cultural repertoire that takes place on two main stages. There is also a Children's Playground, where a programme for children takes place.

There are also competitions and side events for visitors, such as attractions for children, exhibitions and a sightseeing bus that offers rides to see the attractions around the village. For active spectators, there is even the opportunity to get involved directly with their own hands in cooking some of the selected traditional dishes.

The combination of delicacies, music, traditions and entertainment makes the Margecany Festival of Delicacies an exceptional transnational event that wins the hearts of thousands of domestic and international tourists.



International Peace Marathon

The International Peace Marathon (IPM) in Košice is one of the most prestigious sporting events not just in Slovakia, but also globally. With its long tradition dating back to 1924, this marathon is the oldest in Europe and the second oldest in the world. Thousands of runners from dozens of countries take part every year, making it not only a major sporting event, but also a social and cultural highlight.

The route of the Košice Marathon leads through the streets of the historic city centre, lined with crowds of enthusiastic and cheering spectators, as well as through the adjacent parts of the immediate surroundings of Košice.


However, the marathon is not just about the runners on the main route. For those who do not dare to run the entire distance of 42.195 kilometres, other disciplines such as half marathon, relay run or races for inline skaters and wheelchair racers are also available. This opens the event to a wider audience, making it inclusive and accessible to different age and performance groups.

The International Peace Marathon also has a deep social dimension, which is reflected in its name. It symbolises the desire for peace, mutual understanding and solidarity among peoples. This message is underpinned each year by the ceremonial lighting of the 'marathon flame' to express peace and unity. The popularity of the marathon continues to grow and with each passing year, more and more enthusiasts from all over the world join in to be part of this special highlight.

In addition to the sporting performance, the IPM also offers a varied cultural and social programme that enhances the atmosphere of the event. The marathon weekend includes various exhibitions, lectures, and musical events that celebrate not just the sport, but also the history of the traditionally multicultural city of Košice. This festival of sport and culture contributes to popularising the city internationally and makes Košice an attractive destination for tourists and runners from all over the world.









Living Statues Festival

The Festival of Living Statues is a world-renowned event that makes it worth travelling to Slovakia. During the few days that the festival takes place each year, the centre of Spišská Nová Ves is filled with art, music, and associated actions. The Festival of Living Statues brings artists to the streets of the town, imitating immobile statues with their perfect makeup and costumes. They portray a variety of characters from history, mythology, or modern times, and their precise performance can fascinate viewers of all age groups. Their performance is so convincing that at first glance, visitors may believe they are real statues until they make a certain movement or gesture. These changes, whether induced in response to those present or for special effect, often inspire amazement and laughter when viewers discover that a real live person is standing in front of them. Visitors may react to the statues, try to move them, or just admire them from afar. This element of surprise and interactivity makes the festival a dynamic event that is popular among families with children, but also among adults who want to enjoy extraordinary artistic performances.


Various side activities such as workshops, concerts, and other cultural performances also take place during the festival.





The festival takes place in the lens-shaped square in Spišská Nová Ves, which is one of the longest in Europe due to its size and unique shape. The historic buildings and the open area of the square give the whole event a distinctive atmosphere that enhances the experience of this creative artistic encounter in authentic places where the phenomenon, known worldwide as 'Big Names', was founded.

Spiš Castle

The Spiš Castle is one of the most significant symbols of Slovakia. It is listed in the UNESCO World Heritage List and has the status of a national cultural heritage site. Covering an area of over 4 hectares, it ranks among the largest castle complexes in the world. Its history dates to the 12th century, when it was built as a border fortress. During the 15th century, the castle underwent extensive rebuilding and became a representative residence of the nobility.

Currently, the castle is managed by the Spiš Museum in Levoča, which operates several intriguing exhibitions in its premises. The area surrounding the Spiš Castle has preserved its original appearance over the centuries, allowing visitors to admire breathtaking views of the surrounding countryside. One of the castle's attractions includes the geoglyph located on the northern slope of the castle hill. This monumental work of art by Australian sculptor Andrew Roberts, inspired

by motifs from Celtic coins discovered during archaeological excavations, attracts the attention of visitors from afar. The Spiš Castle is also a venue for cultural and social happenings. Traditional castle festivals transport visitors back to the Middle Ages through period crafts, markets, medieval cuisine, sword fights, and musical performances. Equally popular are the night tours with an interesting accompanying programme.








Grand Bari Chateu the Perfect Wedding Day Venue


